With over 23 years of pioneer ministry in the jungles of Ecuador, Joil, Leah, and their four children Andrew, Will, Emelia, and Aidan, and with those who have partnered with them in this endeavor, have come to see over 70 churches planted through the jungle region. Over 7,000 Shuar natives have proclaimed their faith through water baptism, hundreds of men and women study in one of three Bible schools, and hundreds of young women have come through the Ecuador Hope House, finding a secure place to call home from the harsh environments they may have found themselves previously of abuse and exploitation.

Prayer Point:

- Pray for the unreached people groups of the jungles of Ecuador.

EUROPE

Thor + Jenny Erlingsson: Iceland



We are a family learning what it means to say yes to God in beautiful Iceland. After over twelve years of working in inner-city (Lincoln Village Ministry) and church-based (The Rock Family Worship Center) ministry, we followed the call of God to move to Bjarni's home country of Iceland with our four children, Nyema, Thor, Eyja and Moses. For the first two years, our home was in Akureyri, a town in the snowy north of Iceland where we supported a local church, was involved in the community through basketball, built relationships with ministry leaders throughout the country, and started a weekly English program on the Christian radio station. After God's continued leading, we now live in Eyrarbakki, in the south of Iceland, in a home dedicated to not just housing our family but to hosting gatherings and visiting teams. From this location, we can connect further with country-wide leadership, minister to others around the capital area, and plan for work and ministry trips. Bjarni also hosts another weekly program on the radio in Icelandic. We know that God is continuing to unfold our story and location in Iceland so that we can better serve the churches as a whole and impact more people with the love and freedom of Christ.

Prayer Point:

- For our family's continued health, provision, and cover as we travel and kids attend school.
- For the churches and believers whom we support. That they would feel refreshed, see healing and provision in their families, and strength to continue well in their roles.
- For open doors and favor in the community to see more people saved, healed, and delivered.
- Continued wisdom on what we put our hands to and how we steward the opportunities God gives us.
- Breaking off fear and peace in the lingering effects of transition for our kids.

Austin + Tsehaynesh Hendersons: Spain



Our missions journey started in 2017 as just Austin & Tsey. God called us to Vienna, Austria to serve as missionaries and it was there where our first son Atlas was born. Since then, God blessed us with our second son Highland. We knew that God was calling us to move to Spain to plant a church where there is none. That is where we will be going starting Spring 2022.

The Henderson family is currently in their 20th year as fully appointed World Missionaries. Larry was elected to serve as the new AGWM Regional Director for Europe beginning in mid-June 2022. In 2017, Melinda launched The Inspire Project which is focused on encouraging and developing healthy women's ministries: including conferences, retreats, and prayer luncheons. In November 2020, they saw a record of 8,000 women attending the INSPIRE virtual conference.

the Ukrainian language, endeared them to the Ukrainian people, who opened wide their hearts to them and to the Good News which they have brought. In addition to raising many orphans as their own children; the Lord has used Jim and Sandy to do evangelistic crusades, ongoing outreaches to the poor and needy, and to start a church unity movement through the all-children's/youth church which they began. Besides preaching at many churches, Jim has also spoken at pastors' and leaders' conferences, with an emphasis on the power of the Holy Spirit, God's love, and pleading for the cause of orphans, and the poor and needy.
