CORE CLASSES

Year 1

Session 1

Marks of A Leader

This course will discuss the characteristics of a godly leader. Pastors will teach these classes from their experience, knowledge, and wisdom from various ministries.

Defending Your Faith

Session 2

Year 2

Session 1

Biblical Worldview

How do two Bible-believing Christians have differing views on an important issue? This class will explore our thinking process and how the Bible can be the primary lens to view the world.

Sharing Your Faith

Session 2

Theology 2

This course examines key theological beliefs such as Salvation, Church, Death, the End Times, Angels, Demons, Sin, and Miracles and how they influence our behavior.

Learn about spiritual leadership in this course, as we explore how it is embodied in Jesus' life and modeled by key leaders in the Bible.
